Tip to help you improve your English grammar and word usage skills

- Common Grammar Pitfalls:**
 - Subject-verb agreement:** The subject and verb must agree in number and tense.
 - EXAMPLE:** The cat *was* sleeping on the sofa.
 - GRAMMAR TIP:** The subject and verb must agree in number and tense. If the subject is singular, the verb must be singular. If the subject is plural, the verb must be plural.
 - Verb tense:** The verb must be in the correct tense for the context of the sentence.
 - EXAMPLE:** She *was* walking to school when it started to rain.
 - GRAMMAR TIP:** The verb must be in the correct tense for the context of the sentence. Use the correct tense for the time of day, the season, and the situation.
 - Prepositions:** Prepositions are words that show the relationship between a noun and another word in a sentence.
 - EXAMPLE:** The book *is* on the table.
 - GRAMMAR TIP:** Prepositions are words that show the relationship between a noun and another word in a sentence. Use the correct preposition for the situation.
 - Adjectives and adverbs:** Adjectives describe nouns, and adverbs describe verbs.
 - EXAMPLE:** She *was* walking *quickly* to school.
 - GRAMMAR TIP:** Adjectives describe nouns, and adverbs describe verbs. Use the correct word to describe the noun or verb.
 - Conjunctions:** Conjunctions are words that connect two clauses in a sentence.
 - EXAMPLE:** She *was* walking to school, *and* it started to rain.
 - GRAMMAR TIP:** Conjunctions are words that connect two clauses in a sentence. Use the correct conjunction for the situation.
 - Relative clauses:** Relative clauses are clauses that provide more information about a noun.
 - EXAMPLE:** The book *that I read* was interesting.
 - GRAMMAR TIP:** Relative clauses are clauses that provide more information about a noun. Use the correct relative pronoun for the situation.
 - Indefinite pronouns:** Indefinite pronouns are words that refer to a person or thing without naming it.
 - EXAMPLE:** *Someone* was knocking on the door.
 - GRAMMAR TIP:** Indefinite pronouns are words that refer to a person or thing without naming it. Use the correct pronoun for the situation.
 - Quantifiers:** Quantifiers are words that show the amount of something.
 - EXAMPLE:** *Many* people were at the game.
 - GRAMMAR TIP:** Quantifiers are words that show the amount of something. Use the correct quantifier for the situation.
 - Comparatives and superlatives:** Comparatives and superlatives are used to compare two or more things.
 - EXAMPLE:** This car *is* faster *than* that one.
 - GRAMMAR TIP:** Comparatives and superlatives are used to compare two or more things. Use the correct form for the situation.
 - Conditionals:** Conditionals are clauses that show a condition or a possibility.
 - EXAMPLE:** *If* it rains, we *will* cancel the picnic.
 - GRAMMAR TIP:** Conditionals are clauses that show a condition or a possibility. Use the correct form for the situation.
 - Modals:** Modals are auxiliary verbs that are used to show possibility, ability, or obligation.
 - EXAMPLE:** She *can* speak French.
 - GRAMMAR TIP:** Modals are auxiliary verbs that are used to show possibility, ability, or obligation. Use the correct modal verb for the situation.
 - Passive voice:** The passive voice is used when the subject of the sentence is the receiver of the action.
 - EXAMPLE:** The package *was* delivered to my door.
 - GRAMMAR TIP:** The passive voice is used when the subject of the sentence is the receiver of the action. Use the correct form for the situation.
 - Gerunds and infinitives:** Gerunds and infinitives are verb forms that can be used as nouns, adjectives, or adverbs.
 - EXAMPLE:** *Walking* is good exercise.
 - GRAMMAR TIP:** Gerunds and infinitives are verb forms that can be used as nouns, adjectives, or adverbs. Use the correct form for the situation.
